Lesson Plan 7- Respect for Authority

Introduction/Ice Breaker-

- Have the students watch the Leave it to Beaver video
http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=MxmjqGzU_1w
- Ask the students watch the video and have them focus on the children and the way they treat the adults.

Lesson –

- Begin a discussion on the video- Use your experiences on how to educate them as the incorrect and correct ways to treat adults.
 - o Do most freshman today act this way?
 - o What are some similarities with the way your peers act to the boys in the movie?
 - o What are some differences?
 - o Is treating adults this way realistic? Why or why not?
 - o What are some benefits to treating the older generations with respect?
 - o Why do you see a decline in this behavior?
 - o Why should we show respect to adults
 - You never know if who is going to be your boss someday
 - They are wiser than you are they have lived here longer and experienced more
 - Do the 4th graders know more than you? NO WAY!
- Get in groups of two. Have the student's role play with one being a student and the other an adult. Have the students create one scenario with the correct way to treat an adult and the other an incorrect way. After each group gets done have the class discuss both ways and how they were handled.

Closure –

- Journal: Have the students critique themselves on the way they treat parents, teachers, boss, and community members. Are you treating these people fairly?
